



Harpers Environmental Ltd – Summary Key Terms and Conditions

This estimate is subject to the following: Guidelines and full T&C are attached. By accepting this quote you agree to Harpers Environmental Ltd (Harpers) standard terms and conditions.

Please also take particular note of the following terms and conditions:

Waste:

The responsibility for the classification of the waste generated during the cleaning process is the sole responsibility of the waste producer/Client as in law and per Environment Agency Guidance.

Note - All wastes must be declared and offered for transport in accordance with the Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations 2009 (as amended)

Harpers will dispose of waste materials detailed via fully authorised licensed facilities. The description of the waste is the responsibility of the customer. The disposal route and price estimates are subject to acceptance and final analysis by the disposal site. Disposal prices may vary if the waste is not as described by the customer.

Non-Hazardous Waste – It is Harpers understanding (unless advised) from the information the customer has provided the waste you require Harpers to dispose of is classed as Non-Hazardous Waste under the “list of wastes established by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC”. If the material changes or you are aware of other properties not previously stated, please inform us so we may verify the classification, disposal route and price.

Should Harpers in our professional opinion, consider the waste hazardous in accordance with the Hazardous Waste Regulations 2005 (as amended), we shall require your company's SIC code before any hazardous waste can be collected. Harpers will also require a EWC code and description of the waste stream for the necessary paperwork to be raised on your behalf and this will carry an additional charge. All Waste Notes will be provided to the client.

Price:

Any waste stream not conforming to sample or specification will be subject to a potential price variation or repatriation to the waste producer. Any incremental costs due from such circumstances will be subject to standard Harpers rates in place at the time. Standard charges can be supplied if requested.

Any delays on site (including demurrage), not attributable to Harpers equipment or personnel will incur a charge at an appropriate rate per hour (unless advised otherwise beforehand in writing).

Harpers prices are estimated and may vary subject to changes in the scope of work or for unforeseen circumstances (including operational issues, waste type issues, changes due to Health and Safety implications), unless a fixed price is agreed for a clearly defined scope of work.

If a fixed price Quote has been agreed, the scope of work and the terms will be clear and unequivocally stated on the face of the estimate.

Prices are exclusive of land fill Tax if applicable. Any landfill Tax will be charged at the current rate.

All prices are exclusive of value added tax, which will be charged as applicable at the current rate.

The invoice will be sent to the customer after the work is completed (unless agreed otherwise). Any invoice disputes must be advised by email within 5 working days of receipt to accounts@harpersenvironmental.co.uk If no response the invoice will be deemed payable in full at 30days from invoice date (unless agreed otherwise).



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Operational:

Clear and safe access to site is made available by the client.

Clients are to provide Permits to work (or any other permits, licences or permission documentation) and ensure Harpers have good safe access and egress to the work location and all clients' staff is informed of Harpers activities.

The schedule of works to be done as detailed or discussed over the phone is subject to change if unforeseen circumstance arises. Harpers reserve the right to, re-assess the work involved and negotiate variation orders where necessary.

If this estimate is acceptable an order number will be required before commencement of work and our estimate is subject to our standard terms of service and is payable within 30 days of the invoice date.

Cancellation:

If the customer cancels the job Harpers will do its reasonable best to avoid any costs and redeploy its resources to other work. If this is not possible Harpers will charge for costs incurred for example hired equipment of reasonable redeployment charges.

Disputes:

All work will be carried out to the required levels of service agreed. If there are any service issues that could affect subsequent billing these must be advised to the sales person within 2 working days of completion and to Harpers directly by email: enquiries@harpersenvironmental.co.uk
